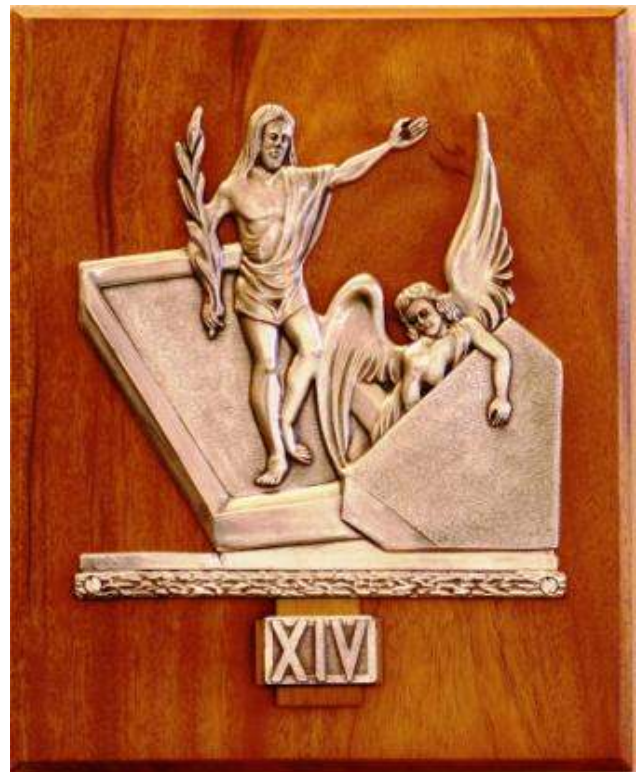


THE FOURTEENTH STATION
